

## **Ryerss Farm for Aged Equines Requirements at Time of Admission**

- The equine must be at least 20 years of age.
- A current veterinary certificate must be provided, stating that the equine is sound and free of communicable diseases.
- Copies of medical records must be provided upon admittance.
- Proof of current tetanus, rabies, EWE and West Nile Virus vaccinations must be provided.

- A Coggins test within one year of admittance.

- Teeth must be checked and floated (if necessary).

- Worming must be done within 30 days prior to admittance.

- We require that shoes are removed prior to admittance and that feet are trimmed. Shoes should be removed immediately after your acceptance of the available opening for your horse. Please ask your vet and farrier for help with treatment for soreness. If shoes need to stay on, former owner must assume cost for the lifetime of the horse.
